Please note the following:

- Media personnel must register for access to the Surrey Celebration Site event using the online accreditation form found [here](#).
- Journalists applying for accreditation must supply their full details; name, organization, type of coverage planned and full contact details (email & cell phone number).
- Freelance journalists should apply online as usual, but must also provide a letter of assignment from an editor of the organization they are representing - either printed on letterhead paper, or in an email originating from the organization's formal domain. If this is required you will be contacted following your media application.
